About the BHC

Aliviane's Behavioral Health Clinic (BHC) is an outpatient clinic serving children, adolescents, adults, and families in need of mental health counseling. BHC therapists are trained to treat a variety of mental health issues including: Trauma; Depression; Anxiety; Attachment Disorder; Conduct Disorder; Step-Family and Adoption Issues; Gender Identity; Divorce & Domestic Exposure; Posttraumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD); School and Home Aggressive Behaviors; Attention Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder (ADD/ADHD); and Medical Trauma.

The BHC also operates two federally funded grant programs, the Community Treatment and Services (CTS) Center through the Substance Abuse & Mental Health Administration (SAMHSA) and the Safe Start Program through the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention.
