<b>Who is Eligible to Receive Your Services</b>	Students enrolled in the Socorro Independent School District: Keys Academy and San Elizario Independent School District: Excell Academy. Youth Indicated Prevention services target a subset of the general population who may already be experimenting with drugs or who exhibit other problem related behaviors. Age 0-17 years of age and young adults 18-21 years of age who meet the curriculum and program requirements to participate in the youth indicated prevention program.
