Description of Services (maximum of 100 words)	Each mother and her child (children) will participate in a minimum of three hours of gender-specific, culturally relevant services each week, for a period of six months. In the three-hour period the mother will participate in two hours of group consisting of trauma focused substance abuse counseling while her child is participating in learning activities in the therapeutic childcare program; the mother and child together will participate in one hour of Parent/Child Interaction.
