Who is Eligible to Receive Your Services	Infants, children, teens and young adults from birth through age 20 can get case management if they are: eligible for Medicaid, have or at risk for having a health problem that keeps them from doing things that other kids their age do, need help getting services to keep health problems from getting worse and want case management.
If you provide services to pregnant women please indicate at what stage of pregnancy your services apply (e.g. 1st month of pregnancy, 3rd month, 6th month, or 9th month)	Women who are pregnant can get case management if they are: eligible for Medicaid, have a high risk pregnancy, need services to prevent more problems with pregnancy and want case management.
