<b>Description of Services (maximum of 100 words)</b>	Our treatment programs are built into the needs of the target population based on several key factors. TRY is a program for adolescents which consist of outpatient-based, comprehensive treatment and experiential regimen provided for youth and their families. The program focuses on client-centered approaches: Individual and group counseling, substance abuse education, life skills training, relapse prevention, specialized female services, and anger management & coping skills. The treatment staff are qualified professionals on chemical dependency. Our counselors offer a full continuum of culturally sensitive treatment services. We accept referrals from Truancy Courts, Juvenile Probation, CIS, schools, family and volunteer self-referrals.
